Quieting Prayer of Introduction:

Leader:

As we enter prayer now, we take a moment to pause...

We breathe deeply and embrace slowness...

Father, help us to be still and know that you are our God...

Take a moment to pause.

Prayer of Immerse

Leader:

Replay your day in your mind. What is occupying your thoughts today? In this time of prayer, your goal is not to become “better” or “more focused” but to hold your life up to the God who loves you and release it to Him. Your goal is to truly present yourself to Him and receive His loving gaze upon you.

**As events from your day come to mind, hold them and whisper in prayer,
“Jesus, I give everyone and everything to you...”**

Closing Prayer: based on Daniel 9:4-6, 15-19

Pray Together:

Now, God, hear the prayers and petitions of your people. For your sake, Lord, look with favor on your church. We do not make requests of you because we are righteous, but because of your great mercy. Lord, listen! Lord, forgive! Lord, hear and act!

For your sake do not delay, because your church and your people bear your name.

- Pray for the love God has for us corporately as His gathered people called Point of Grace. Pray that we would live into the identity that He has specifically called us to. Pray that we would measure success not by numbers but by the Holy Spirit.

3 Prayer: Pour out your Spirit to raise up an evangelistic heart in Your Church

- Pray that Point of Grace would be able to go wider than we could even ask for or imagine.
- Pray that He would raise up people in this church who are willing to commit to a life of BLESS-ing other as a missionary in their own context.
- Pray that God would raise up and lead Point of Grace to the next person He would call to fill the Children’s Ministry Director Position.
- Pray for wisdom and guidance for our leaders about what it means to “replicate kingdom locations.” How does Jesus want His church to

Leader:

Take a moment as a group to celebrate the gifts God has given you recently. As you were replaying your day, did you find anything worth celebrating? Any gifts that you missed in the moment?

Pray them aloud conversationally and with one another. Celebrate what the Lord has done.

Prayer for Revival

Reader: Ephesians 3.16-20

Together: Prayer based on the Ephesians 3.16-20 text

Jesus, root us and establish us in your love!

Holy Spirit, unite us together as a church locally and globally with all people that you have redeemed.

Father, give us your power so that we can cling to how wide and long and high and deep your love is for us.

Jesus, we pray for power to know your love intimately, personally and corporately for us that surpasses knowledge. Help us fall deeper in love with you.

As your church called Point of Grace we pray that you fill us to all the measure of all the fullness of God.

Leader: Number people off in groups of 3, each person will be either a 1, 2 or 3. Each person will take turns praying for their designated prayer prompt.

Leader tip: Keep an eye on the time and after 3 minutes indicate for the groups when to transition to the next prayer.

1 Prayer: Pour out your Spirit on our church, on families, on individuals and in ministry areas.

- Helpful prayer ideas: Children's Ministry, Sunday Morning Worship, Youth Group, Grow Groups, Middle School, ACE Classes, Young Adults, Prayer Ministry, Serve Ministry, the invitational culture of Point of Grace, Hospitality Team, Leadership Team, Pastor, Staff
- **Tip:** *Don't worry about covering all the areas. Instead let your prayers draw towards things that are close to your heart.*
